In an effort to help relieve the workload in Dispatch, Sheriff's Office personnel **shall not** contact the Sheriff's Office Communications Unit and request them to make routine telephone calls. All Units and Command Officers are expected to cooperate in this effort.

Requests such as, but not limited to, "contact court, I'll be late, call Central Garage and see if vehicle is ready, call the Range and see if it is open," etc., will have to be made by the individual desiring the information.

Should such a request be made, the Communications Agent receiving the call shall advise the Communications Supervisor who will advise the Command Sergeant at 248-858-4954.
