SUBJECT:	SMOKING REGULATIONS	DISTRIBUTION 1
REFERENCE:	Rescinds and replaces General Order 19, dated February 27, 2004	

All law enforcement buildings under the control of the Oakland County Sheriff's Office are designated as **NON-SMOKING AREAS**. No smoking shall be permitted at any main exterior entrance to or exit from a Sheriff's Office building. This will apply to all citizens, employees, and inmates.

### INMATES

Possession of cigarettes or tobacco by inmates in any facility will be considered contraband and appropriate violation notices will be issued.

### SHERIFF'S OFFICE PERSONNEL

Pursuant to Rules and Regulations No. 122 **Use of Tobacco**, uniformed members may smoke or chew tobacco when not in direct contact with the citizens-or inmates. They shall not smoke or chew when involved in any formal detail or duty. They shall not smoke or chew in any county vehicle.
