This order replaces and rescinds all previously issued orders, procedures, rules and regulations, notices and/or practices in conflict with this General Order.

I. POLICY

Effective June 1, 2024, the Oakland County Sheriff's Office shall admit parole absconders into the Oakland County Jail **only** if there is an active warrant or parole violation hold.

II. PROCEDURES

A. Michigan Department of Corrections (MDOC) Contact

1. The Booking Supervisor shall call the MDOC 24-hour Electronic Monitoring Unit at 1-800-877-5664, extension #3, to confirm the warrant or parole violation hold.
2. MDOC will notify the inmate's parole agent that they are in custody at the Oakland County Jail.

B. Booking Supervisor

1. The dayshift Booking Supervisor is responsible for monitoring the number of MDOC parole absconders admitted into the Oakland County Jail. The dayshift Booking Supervisor must confirm the MDOC parole absconder are admitted only on an active warrant or parole violation hold. The dayshift Booking Supervisor must also track inmates who are finished with local sentences/charges and therefore ready to be released to the MDOC.
2. The dayshift Booking Supervisor shall prepare a daily list of inmates who may be released to the MDOC.

3. The list will be distributed to the MDOC Parole Offices, Probation/Parole Manager, Executive Lieutenant, and Sheriff's Office Accountant.
4. The Oakland County Sheriff's Office will admit parole absconders into the jail only if there is an active warrant or parole violation hold. These individuals will be held for no more than twenty-four (24) hours for MDOC to pick them up.
5. Inmates who become available due to finishing local sentence/charges will be held by the Oakland County Sheriff's Office for no more than eight (8) hours for MDOC to pick them up.
6. An MDOC only inmate who requires hospitalization, will be monitored by the Oakland County Sheriff's Office for no more than eight (8) hours upon that inmate's admission to the medical facility.
7. Upon an inmate's availability (finishing local sentences/charges), to MDOC the Booking Supervisor shall call the Parole Agent. If unable to reach the Agent than call the Supervisor. If both are unavailable, send an email to both and copy the Regional Manager to notify them of the pending release from custody.
8. The Booking Sergeant or a Corrections Command Officer, may extend the time of the hold if prior arrangements have been made and confirmed with the MDOC. Concerns or problems shall be reported to the Executive Lieutenant or designee.
