SUBJECT: RADIO PROCEDURES/COURT SERVICES	DISTRIBUTION A, B, D-I & D-II.	
REFERENCE:		

1.0 VEHICULAR RADIOS

- 1.1 Vehicular radios shall remain "on" with sufficient volume to allow the transport officers to receive calls at all times.
- 1.2 When transport officers leave the transmission area, then the radio shall be turned to "State Calling" to insure continuous communication.
- 1.3 Vehicles equipped with the old radio system shall also turn that radio to MEPS when leaving transmission area.

2.0 "PREP" RADIO

- 2.1 Prep radios shall be carried by officers at all times during transportation of inmates.
- 2.2 Prep radios are to remain "off" when officers are in Court sessions, unless the radio is activated by the Court-Assigned Officer in order to request assistance in the Courtroom.
- 2.3 Officers radios that are equipped with earphones may leave their radios on. Volume should be at a level that allows the officer to maintain their attention to the activities within the court.
- 2.4 Officers are responsible for proper care and maintenance of prep radios and batteries. Batteries shall be re-charged when necessary to insure good working condition of the radios.
