Please add the following to the above-referenced order:

Item 1.6 – after the sentence ending with “fashion” and the next sentence beginning with “Operations” insert the following sentence: ***Owners of stolen vehicles will be contacted on an annual basis to ensure that the vehicle is still outstanding.***

After 1.8, add the following:

2.0 **CRIMINAL OFFENSE FOR VIOLATIONS UNDER MCLA 28.214, SECTION 4**

- {2} *A person shall not disclose information from the law enforcement information network to a private entity for any purpose, including, but not limited to, the enforcement of child support programs.*
- {3} *A person shall not disclose information from the law enforcement information network in a manner that is not authorized by law or rule. A violation of this subsection is a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a fine of not more than \$500.00 or both. A second or subsequent violation is a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 4 years or a fine of not more than \$2000.00, or both.*
