Information: The uploading feature in CommandCentral will be disabled effective February 1, 2026, at 0800 hours.

Affected Application: CommandCentral

Date: February 1, 2026, 0800 hours

Action Required: As of February 1, 2026, at 0800 hours, the uploading feature in CommandCentral will be disabled. Going forward, the Sheriff's Office will use the 'Cases' function in Video Manager, as instructed during the Winter In-Service Training.

All evidence uploaded to CommandCentral **prior to February 1** will **still be accessible** in CommandCentral. However, it is recommended that any **active cases** currently in CommandCentral be transferred to 'Cases' in VideoManager.
