HIT/RUN CODES PER MSP

**Information:** Traffic accidents are not reported to MICR except if it is due to Driving While Intoxicated, Hit and Run (of a person outside a vehicle) and Negligent Homicide Involving a Vehicle. For MICR purposes, Hit and Run (54001) is defined as “the **accidental striking** of a person or persons outside of a vehicle (walker, jogger, bicyclist, etc.) where the offender fails to stop and identify or give assistance.”

If a person is struck **intentionally**, this would be Aggravated Assault (13002) or Homicide (09001/9003), with the vehicle as the weapon.

If an empty vehicle is struck **intentionally**, it is Damage to Property (29000).

If a vehicle strikes another vehicle **unintentionally** (whether the offender leaves or not), this is merely a traffic violation (93001; not MICR reportable). If a vehicle hits something else **unintentionally** (tree, building, etc.), the code is 93002 (also not MICR reportable).

A UD-10 (Traffic Crash Report) is completed for **all** crashes, regardless of whether a person, vehicle or piece of property is struck (intentionally or unintentionally) and regardless of whether the offender leaves or not.
