MULTIPLE CFS NUMBERS RELATED TO SWAT, K9, DRONE, ETC.

INFORMATION:

Effective immediately, all OCSO incidents that include SWAT, K9, DRONE, etc., with a CLEAR report will only require one (1) CFS number. The practice of using multiple numbers for the same incident has created confusion and, in some cases, has let to unnecessary disputes and litigation.

Action Required:

Deputies are instructed NOT to pull multiple (two) numbers for these reports.

Deputies should write a point/supplement to the original report and add an offense, such as:

- K9 Tracking – OS
- SWAT Callout – OS
- Drone Deployment (Suicidal/Missing Person) – OS

If assisting a department other than OCSO, units can pull a CFS with the appropriate offense(s) as necessary, such as:

- C3330 Assist Other Lw Enforcement Agency and K9 Tracking – OS
- SWAT Callout – OS
- Drone Deployment-Other Agency-OS and Drone Deployment (Suicidal/Missing Person) – OS

The Records Unit will ensure the proper release of information and will check with OICs as necessary prior to releasing any case reports.
