SECONDARY INCIDENT OFFENSE CODES

**Information:** Certain types of reports should always have two offenses listed to make it clear what actions OCSO deputies actually performed on a call. The Sheriff, along with mayors, township supervisors/boards, media staff and others, frequently ask what exactly was done on a call. Adding a second, more specific offense helps tremendously in answering these questions and helps keep the most accurate records possible.

**Action Required:** When necessary, please ensure that an additional offense code is added to reflect what specific action was taken on the call. The following are the most common:

**Assist Fire:** Add another code such as *Sick Care For, Injured Person, Overdose, Structure Fire*, etc.

**Assist Other Agency:** Add a secondary L or C code that explains why we are assisting the agency.

**Attempted Suicide or Suicide:** Add *Mental Health*. (NOTE: We need to keep track of how often we respond to *Mental Health* Calls for Service, so this code needs to be utilized consistently when necessary.)

Not all reports need a second code, and the ones that do are not limited to the above.

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
