COMPLETING CLEAR REPORTS FOR WARRANT ARRESTS

Information:

Deputies should no longer use the following offense codes:

C3010 Felony Arrest Warrant (Originating Agency)

C3020 Misdemeanor Arrest Warrant (Originating Agency)

C3030 Traffic Arrest Warrant

C3040 Felony Arrest Warrant (Other Jurisdiction)

C3050 Misdemeanor Arrest Warrant (Other Jurisdiction)

Deputies may still use the following offense codes:

C3045 Extradition Arrest Warrant

C3070 Civil/Friend of the Court Arrest Warrant

C3338 Arrest Assist Other Agency

5015 Fail to Appear

5012 Probation Violation

1. When a warrant arrest is made by OCSO on an original complaint/warrant out of our own agency/ORI:

An OCSO deputy enters arrest data into the original incident/report within CLEAR as an additional point.

Example 1: Suspect 1 committed a B&E on 01/01/2015; Incident #15-725 is opened. Suspect is initially unknown. Further investigation reveals suspect's identity and a warrant is issued. Suspect is located and arrested; arrest data is entered into original Incident #15-275 as an additional point.

2. When a warrant arrest is made by OCSO on another agency's original complaint/warrant (including a different ORI):

The arresting agency (OCSO) enters an Original (new) ASSIST incident/report into CLEAR with the offense code of **C3338 – Arrest Assist Other Agency**. Arrest data is given to the originating agency so they can update and clear/close their original complaint.

Example 2: Suspect 2 committed arson on 2/15/2015 in Livonia PD's jurisdiction. Livonia PD identifies suspect and a warrant is issued. OCSO makes the arrest on 3/11/2015. OCSO enters an Original Assist under **C3338 – Arrest Assist Other Agency**.

3. When 'Fail to Appear' or 'Bench' warrants result in an arrest and warrant originated outside of OCSO's ORI (i.e., from a court):

Because the 'Fail to Appear' is a new complaint subsequent to the original complaint, an OCSO deputy will open an original (new) complaint/report in CLEAR. The offense file class category is 50000 (Obstructing Justice); the deputy should specifically use **5015 – Fail to Appear** or **5012 – Probation Violation** as applicable. This complaint/report will be listed as **Cleared by Arrest**.

Example 3: Suspect 3 committed larceny on 3/1/2015 in Redford PD's jurisdiction and was arrested on the spot. Suspect was issued an 'Appearance Notice' for 3/30/2015 but did not appear for the hearing. Suspect was later arrested by OCSO on this outstanding warrant, using either **5015** or **5012** as the offense code.

In examples 2 and 3, if another offense file class (or crime) occurs during the warrant pickup (within OCSO's jurisdiction), the OCSO deputy should open a second complaint/report for the new offense. DO NOT include the new crime on the same report as the warrant arrest.
