OCSO Black Uniform Exterior Ballistic Vest Carrier Flag Patch

After the *30-day Fit/Adjustment Period*, Deputies are required to take their Exterior Ballistic Vest to the contracted vendor below to have the USA Flag patch affixed. Deputies are to liaison with their respective command to arrange drop off and pick up, as ERP overtime is not authorized.

Father and Son Cleaners will complete the service with a **one-day** turnaround time and have the authorized Flag Patch on hand. Deputies are to drop their vest off **without** the ballistic panels or any equipment in the respective holders. Holders attached to the vest carrier may remain on the vest, however, must not contain items. Deputies may wear their undershirt vest carrier, under their Black Class B Uniform, during this process.

The Flag Patch will be attached onto the exterior layer of the vest carrier, approximately ¼" above the Velcro nametag, allowing adequate space for the nametag (above the right breast pocket) and justified to the left side of the nametag.
